These statistics may excite you, but behind every figure is a story of a person who is being seen, known and valued by someone investing in them.


Our vision is for every single member of the Stewards' Trust 'family' to be mentored or become a mentor.

### **HOW TO BOOK**

When it comes to booking, there are two types of events:

- 1. Direct through our website all youth and student events and some adult events.
- Initial contact with event contact family houseparties and remaining adult events.

Ultimately, you will need to complete an online booking form for both types but some events require you to express interest to the event contact first due to complexities relating to accommodation or youth groups.

All balances must be paid 12 weeks prior to the event. Once booked, all communication should be with your event contact.

### PETS

We regret that no pets may be taken on any of our events - sorry.

### **ENQUIRIES**

For youth and student events, please contact the Stewards' Trust office. For all other events and houseparties, your enquiries should be addressed to the relevant event contact whose contact details you will find in the brochure and on our website.

### VOLUNTEERS

Volunteer helpers are required for our family, youth and student events. Please apply to the relevant event contact or, for youth and student events, to the Stewards' Trust office. Helpers are sometimes asked to make a contribution towards their living expenses on the event.

### ADDITIONAL NEEDS

Some children and adults at risk have needs which require extra support. Our desire is to be as inclusive as possible within the guidelines of suitable provision and resources. We therefore require parents/carers to provide full details (i.e. disability, allergy, medical condition, medication etc.) at the time of booking. Please also inform us if a child or adult at risk currently has, or has recently experienced, any behavioural or social problems that may affect their own safety or the well-being of others at the event.

For youth and student events, please contact the Stewards' Trust office. For other events and houseparties, please inform the event contact in the first instance.

### CHILDREN AND ILLNESS

Do check your chosen event to ensure a week best geared to your family. Please note that, other than for our youth only events, parents remain responsible for the safety and security of the children they bring to each event other than for the times they are expressly left in the care of the event's youth team. Guests will understand that, in fairness to others, a child (or anyone else) with an infectious disease needs to be taken away.

### SAFEGUARDING AND SAFETY

The safety of everyone attending our events is taken very seriously. We have particular concern for young people and adults at risk. The Stewards' Trust has a Safeguarding Policy, which complies with national standards, and all leaders and team members are subject to this. They are subject to an enhanced disclosure issued by the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) and references also have to be provided. Further details in relation to the safeguarding policy can be found on our website.

Outdoor pursuit activities are carried out under qualified supervision. All leaders and team members agree to abide by its terms.

## Terms & Conditions

### BURSARIES

Financial assistance may be available for those who cannot afford the full cost of an event or houseparty. However, this is limited so please consider other options (your broader family, church etc.) before applying to the Stewards' Trust • For youth and student events, please contact the office for more information on our Transformational Bursary Fund (TBF). For all other events and houseparties, please apply to the relevant event contact as soon as possible • In all instances, you will be asked to give details of why assistance is required and state what contribution you can make • The Stewards' Trust relies on private donations and aims to help those employed in full-time Christian ministry to attend events. If you wish to contribute to the Stewards' Trust for this purpose, donations would be warmly welcomed. We will be happy to advise you on how best to do this.

### DATA PROTECTION

Any personal data provided by you shall be processed by the Stewards' Trust in compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and any subsequent or amending legislation. The Stewards' Trust will keep such information secure and will not release it to any third party. Our full Privacy Policy can be found on our website.

### LIABILITY

The Stewards' Trust wishes to remind you that (except in the case of their negligence or wilful default) neither the Stewards' Trust, the event/houseparty host team nor the venue accept any liability for any death, injury to persons, illness or property damage of any kind occurring during an event or houseparty.

### CANCELLATION

All deposits are non-refundable. If you cancel within six weeks prior to the start of an event or houseparty and your place cannot be filled, you will be liable for the full cost of the event unless you are advised otherwise by your event administrator. You may therefore wish to consider holiday cancellation insurance.

### THE STEWARDS' TRUST RESERVES THE RIGHT TO:

Refuse any application • alter or cancel an event where necessary • ask a guest to leave an event if their behaviour is incompatible with the general enjoyment and wellbeing of others. When this applies to a child, the parent/guardian will be informed. Collection arrangements must be made and no refund will be given.

### INSURANCE
