### Focus and Role Context

The core purpose of The ST is to provide opportunities for Christian discipleship and fellowship to all ages and stages of faith. This is done via our Christian teaching events ('events'), mentoring, and through our Youth Team encouraging and supporting young people in their faith at school and university.

ST events are for all ages but fall into three categories: 'Youth', 'Family/All Age' and 'Adults'. This role is to specifically focus on your youth and student events.

### Strategy

- Working with the Chief Executive to create, communicate and implement a strategy to maintain and grow our youth and student events.

### Youth & Student events

You will be responsible for the oversight of the following events:

- Easter Youth Camps (Impact, Explore, Activate and Revise)
- Pre-Christmas Youth Camp (Catalyst)
- Student weekends (Pre-freshers, Southern Unis and Northern Unis)
- Annual Planning Day (training and planning for Easter Camps)

### Youth work & line-management

- Training and developing the Discipleship & Leadership interns
- Speaking - both supporting DLYs and speak at events if required
